# Grilled Peaches with Fresh Michigan Cherry Sauce

#### Sauce:

- 1 pound Michigan cherries, pitted (about 1 cup)
- 1 tablespoon sugar
- 1/2 cup red wine
- 1 teaspoon balsamic vinegar
- 1 teaspoon cherry liqueur

#### Peaches:

- 4 medium peaches
- 2 tablespoons unsalted butter
- 2 tablespoons brown sugar
- 1 cup vanilla ice cream, optional
- 4 benne wafers

#### **Directions:**

- 1. Heat grill to medium-high.
- In a cast iron skillet over the grill, combine the pitted cherries, sugar, red wine, and balsamic vinegar.
- Bring to a simmer and cook, stirring occasionally, until the fruit is soft, 6 to 8 minutes. Transfer the mixture to a food processor and puree until completely smooth.
- 4. Return the mixture to the skillet over medium-high heat. Add the cherry liqueur and simmer until reduced to about 1/4 cup, 1 to 2 minutes.



- Cut the peaches in half and remove and discard the pits. Place the halves in a medium bowl.
- In a small saucepan set over low heat, melt the butter and brown sugar together. Coat the peaches with the butter mixture.
- Grill the peaches over direct medium heat until grill marks are clearly visible and the peaches are soft, 10 to 12 minutes, turning once halfway through grilling time.
- 8. While the peaches are still warm, layer each serving glass with 2 peach halves, 1 scoop of ice cream, and 1 tablespoon of cherry sauce. Tuck a couple of benne wafers into each glass and serve immediately.

If you have hypothyroidism (low thyroid issues), and take **levothyroxine**, please note that this condition is nine times more likely to occur in women. TMJ issues which are aggravated hormonally (pre-and postmenstrual and pre-and postmenopausal) are three times more likely to occur in women.

If you are taking **amlodipine** for high blood pressure issues, you can experience a large swelling of the gum tissues called gingival hyperplasia. The same condition exists in patients taking medications for epilepsy.

If you are taking **omezprazole** for GERD or reflux issues, your normal bacteria inside your colon will be disrupted and you must take daily probiotics to balance your needed bacteria. Further, this medication depletes your Vitamin B 12 levels so you will need to increase your Vitamin B supplements. All Vitamin B and C supplements are watersoluble which means that they flow easily through your body.

If you are taking **Zoloft** as an antidepressant, it can cause bruxing, clenching, and enhanced bleeding. If you are experiencing new instances of grinding or clenching, you may need to use a mouthguard daily.
